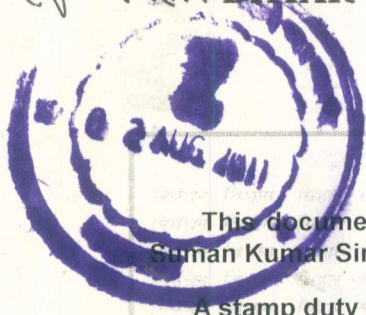

1. AIMS AND OBJECTS

a. The foundation is dedicated to its Mission of providing comprehensive quality education & health care to all sections of the society in general and to economically backward section in particular on affordable cost that are vital for the well being of humankind and robust development of the society.

b. In furtherance of this Mission, the foundation will primarily focus its efforts and resources for the development & consolidation of human resources.

c. In pursuance of its Mission, the foundation will undertake or facilitate/support work and activities aimed at :

i. Establishing educational institutions like School, College, Libraries, Reading rooms etc.

ii. Establishing institutions to impart technical educations in the field like ENGINEERING, PLOYTECHNIC, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, BIO-TECHNOLOGY, MANAGEMENT, MEDICAL, PARA-MEDICAL & ENVIRONMENT etc. and obtain recognition & affiliation from Govt. and other competent forums.

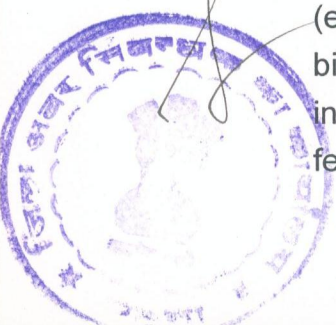

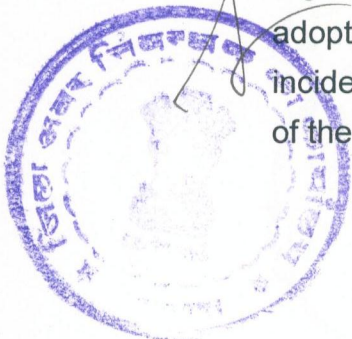

4. The foundation will also undertake or facilitate/support programme, projects & field activities related to its Mission and take up such other work, or activity including medial relations, publications, newsletters, seminars, workshops, meetings, conferences etc, as may be necessary time to time.

5. The foundation will collaborate and work with Government bodies and agencies, likeminded non-Government organizations and individuals as well as academic & scientific institutions and others, for all or any of the aforesaid purposes.

All the income, earnings, movable and / or immovable properties of the Trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profit or in any manner whatsoever to the present Trustees or to any persons claiming through any one of present or past Trustees. No Trustee shall have any personal claim on any movable and / or immovable properties of the Trust or make any profit whatsoever by virtue of his or her trusteeship, provided that nothing herein shall prevent payment of any remuneration to any officer or to any employee of the Trust or to any Trustee of the Trust or to any other person for services actually rendered by them in connection with the aims and objects of the Trust.

2. PROPERTY VESTED IN THE TRUSTEES

The founders jointly do hereby transfer a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) in favour of the Trust and unto the Trustees thereof. The Trustees shall hold the said fund and other properties that may be endowed or conferred in favour of the said Trust for the use and benefit of the trust. The Trustees shall, out of the income realized from the properties endowed and such other endowments or donations or receipts which they may get, pay all taxes and rates, and all expenditure connected with the Trust.

3. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

a. The Board of Trustees will ordinarily consist of not less than Three and not more than Seven members. Mr. Abhimanyu Kumar Singh son of Late Banke Bihari Singh resident of Village & Post Dardha, District Aurangabad, in the State of Bihar. shall hold office for life and act as the Managing Trustee. The Trustees may co-opt other persons to the Board of Trustees as may be necessary, from time to time.

b. The Trustees co-opted shall hold office for Three years only, at the end of which they shall retire automatically, The Trustees whose term of office expires after the period of three years are eligible to be co-opted as Trustees again by the existing Trustees. A Trustee may, if he/she so desire, resign his/her trusteeship even before the expiry of the term of his/her trusteeship.

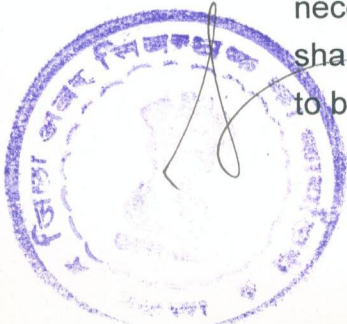
c. The Trustees shall appoint from among the founder trustees, or their nominees a Managing Trustee of the Board of Trustees, who shall act as Chairperson and preside at all the meetings of the Trust and the Board of Trustees. The managing Trustee shall hold his office on rotational basis.

4. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

a. The Board of Trustees shall meet as often as necessary but at least twice a year and their proceedings shall be recorded regularly in the Minutes Book of the Trust to be maintained for the purpose.

b. All the meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be convened by one of the founder trustees.

c. In the absence of the Managing Trustee at any meeting, the Trustees present may elect from among themselves the Chairperson of the meeting.

5. QUORUM

The Quorum of the meetings of the Board of Trustees shall not be less than two Trustees, out of which at least one must be a Founder Trustee.

6. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

a. The Trust may receive donations of money and/or properties, which when received shall be at the absolute disposal of the Trust.

b. The Trustees shall invest the properties and money of the Trust in such manner as prescribed under Section 11 of the Income Tax Act – 1961 and other statutory laws, as applicable.

c. The Trustees may open and operate current or savings deposit accounts or other accounts with any scheduled bank or banks and, by resolution, authorize any one or more of the Trustees, either singly or jointly or severally, to operate such accounts.

d. To set up and conduct interest free financial institutions and to make provisions for interest free loan specially to construct a School of Akshar Vidya Griha Building

e. The settler Suman Kumar Singh, Trustee Mukesh Kumar, Sugreev Roy, Anil Kumar, Ram Gopal Singh and Dinesh Kumar Das hereby also authorized **Mr. Abhimanyu Kumar Singh** vide Resolution No.03, dated 24-07-2010 to obtain loan from Government Institution, Semi Government and Central Government/ any Nationalize Bank, Co-operative Bank or any Financial Institution to Develop Akshar Vidya Griha under Akshar Foundation Trust and to full fill all formalities wherever required and put his signature on behalf of Trust and AKshar Vidya Griha and settler –cum-trustees have further no claim and there is no need of other trustees and settler's signature.

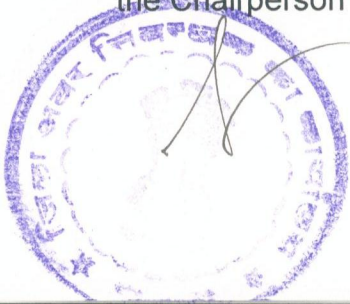
h. The Board may, by resolution, extend the activities of the Trust or undertake any work in furtherance of the main objects of the Trust.

i. In any resolution to be passed relating to the administration of the Trust, the opinion of the Two- Third majority shall prevail. It shall be competent, however, for the Trustees to decide matters by circulation.

j. Proper books of accounts shall be maintained by the Trust and shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant to be appointed by the Board of Trustees, from time to time.

k. The Trustees shall do such other lawful things or acts as are incidental to carrying out the management and administration of the Trust.

l. The Trustees shall maintain the Minutes Book of the Trust, in which the proceedings of all meetings of the Trustees shall be recorded and the same shall be signed by the Chairperson of each meeting.

m. The Trustees may frame rules and regulations concerning the role, responsibilities and duties of each trustee, and may establish committees, Sub-Committees or advisory groups and the mode of conducting any matter connected with the administration of the Trust and its management.

n. The Board of Trustees shall constitute a governing Council for each of the institutions run by the Trust in Accordance with the Rules for the time being in force. The function of such governing council shall be only advisory on matters relating to organization, management and administration of the Institution.

7. CUSTODY OF DOCUMENTS

The Managing Trustee or his nominee or any other Trustee, if so authorized by the Board of Trustees, shall have the custody of all documents, deeds of title, etc relating to the Trust properties and investments, the books of account and other records relating to the Trust and shall be responsible for the preservation of the same.

8. IRREVOCABILITY

It is declared that the Trust setup under this deed of Declaration is irrevocable, and if the Trust fails or for any reason, in the opinion of the Trustees, the net assets of the Trust, both movable and immovable, shall be handed over to any other body having the same or similar objects, as decided by the Two-Third majority of the Trustees at that time.

9. AMENDMENTS

The rules and regulations of the Trust shall be amended by a two third majority of the Trustees.
